

How to access eJournals?

Easy, if you know the title of the journal do the following:

1. Log into the Uni's network via Wifi with a VPN Network from home, or use a public Uni PC (here you can find an instruction for VPN: [IT - VPN \(uni-muenster.de\)](https://www.uni-muenster.de/it/vpn))
2. Go to: EZB (Electronic Journals Library):
[Journal Search | Electronic Journals Library \(uni-regensburg.de\)](https://www.uni-regensburg.de/ejb/)
3. Enter the name of the Journal into the corresponding field "Titlewords"

If you look for an article about a specific topic, use:

Sage: [Advanced Search: SAGE Journals \(sagepub.com\)](https://www.sagepub.com/advanced-search)
